

Guidelines for Posters

Maximum poster size is 2 metre in length/height by 95 centimetres width/ base.

There will be three groups of poster presentations, one on each day of the conference. These will be arranged by theme. You will be assigned a day and poster number. Please attach your poster to the relevant numbered board before 10:15am on the day of your poster session, and please remove the poster at the end of the day. Fixings will be provided. A member of the Conference Team will also be on hand to assist you, should you require help.
